

Is my baby sick with COVID-19?

Signs to look for and what to do:

1



Fever or low temperature

- Your baby feels warmer or colder than usual.
- Your baby's temperature is below 36.5C or above 37.5C.

2



Fussy and not eating well

Your baby is

- Fussy.
- Not eating well.
- Is vomiting.
- Has runny poo.

4



Phone 8-1-1

Phone HealthLink BC at 8-1-1 or your doctor or midwife and tell them about your baby's symptoms. They may tell you to take your baby to the hospital.

Breathing problems

- Your baby is breathing very fast.
- You see your baby's ribs when he or she is breathing.
- Your baby is making grunting sounds when breathing.
- Your baby is coughing.
- Your baby looks pale, you may see blue or grey colour around your baby's mouth.

Go to the hospital

If you are asked to take your baby to the hospital phone the hospital to let the staff know you are coming. Tell them if you or someone living with you or your baby has COVID-19 or may be infected.
